- Te Arai is the last untouched ocean beach in the Auckland region. We ask that Te Arai remain undeveloped and preserved for future generations to enjoy.
- 8 native shorebird species live in the area, 5 of which are endangered, 1 is NZ's rarest bird (the Fairy tern) Only 35-40 individuals Fairy terns remain. We believe the proposed development would place unacceptable risks on native birds and wildlife.
- We ask the government to limit coastal development, as urbanization of our coastal regions is destroying NZ's natural landscapes and precious eco-systems. Reckless development is placing NZ's natural character under threat.
- We the undersigned call on regional and central government to preserve Te Arai and its hinterland.
